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## Fatigue Management Policy

Trades Labour Hire Pty Ltd acknowledges its duty of care to provide and maintain a working environment in which employees are not exposed to hazards or risks in accordance with national statutory and non-statutory legal obligations and other requirements.

Trades Labour Hire Pty Ltd is committed to ensure employees/workers of Trades Labour Hire Pty Ltd are provided with reasonable working hours, whilst taking into account each and all respective hostworkplace environments and practices.

In accordance with Trades Labour Hire Pty Ltd's Fatigue Management Program, the following strategies shall be applied to each individual host-workplace to manage hazards and/or risks associated with fatigue:

- All jobs-tasks, workplace environments and operations are assessed for hazards and/or risks associated with fatigue before mobilisation;
- Information obtained from each risk assessment is used to complete a Task Specific Analysis to identify any underlying fatigue hazards or risks;
- Any hazards or risks identified from the Risk Assessment and Task Analysis are collaboratively addressed with all stakeholders by means of practicable control measures;
- Regular educative training and instruction is also provided by Trades Labour Hire Pty Ltd to maintain effective fatigue management awareness;
- Information provided shall include signs and symptoms of fatigue, associated hazards, risks and legal obligations and other responsibilities;
- Each of these processes shall undergo regular monitoring and review to ensure currency and accuracy and effectiveness of the program is upheld.
