
3 Fun Classroom Management Strategies


Progress Ladder



Set up a progress ladder in the classroom with each of the steps labelled from Good to Outstanding. Normally, this can be done by writing students names on pegs to be placed on a display board, but as a CRT you can do this quickly by just writing the names on a whiteboard.

Wall of Questions

When students have questions during class which cannot be addressed immediately, they can write it down on a post-it note and place it on the wall. This ensures the class isn't disrupted and allocates a proper time to go through questions from the class.



Experiment with ways to gain attention



Raising your voice to call attention of the class can strain your voice and often invite your students to raise their voices as well. Instead, try out techniques such as call and response songs, silent hand signals or repeatable clapping rhythms. Ensure students know the expectations and practice the chosen method at the start of the day/lesson.
