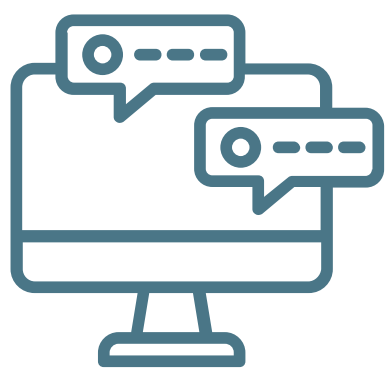




The Educator Guide to Social Media



Protecting Your Privacy on Social Media

Avoid sending it via email or text since anything that is digital can be copied and pasted deliberately or by accident. Limit the audience of what you post can provide you with a reasonable amount of privacy.
